

James A. Brink is Selected as the Fourth Warren K. Sinclair Keynote Speaker

James A. Brink has been selected to give the fourth Warren K. Sinclair Keynote Address at the 2007 Annual Meeting of the National Council on Radiation Protection and Measurements (NCRP). The address, entitled *Use and Misuse of Radiation in Medicine*, will be a featured presentation at the NCRP 43rd Annual Meeting to be held April 16 and 17, 2007. The presentation will be given in the Crystal Forum of the Crystal City Marriott, 1999 Jefferson Davis Highway, Arlington, Virginia at 8:15 a.m. on April 16, 2007. The keynote speaker series honors Dr. Warren K. Sinclair; NCRP's second President (1977 to 1991) and President Emeritus (1991 to present).

Dr. Brink is Professor and Chair of the Department of Diagnostic Radiology at Yale University, School of Medicine, and Chief of Diagnostic Imaging at Yale-New Haven Hospital. Dr. Brink was a staff radiologist and Assistant Professor of Radiology at Mallinckrodt Institute of Radiology from 1990 to 1997 and Co-Director of Computed Body Tomography from 1996 to 1997. He has a BS in Electrical Engineering from Purdue University, an MD from Indiana University School of Medicine, and an honorary MA from Yale University.

Dr. Brink is a fellow of the Society for Computed Body Tomography and Magnetic Resonance and the American College of Radiology. He serves on the board of directors of the Academy of Radiology Research and also on the executive council of the American Roentgen Ray Society. He has been a member of NCRP since 2005. Dr. Brink's service to NCRP includes: Program Committee for the NCRP Symposium on Computed Tomography in 2002; Program Area Committee 4, Radiation Protection in Medicine; and Program Committee for the 2007 Annual Meeting. He is also a member of the Radiological Society of North America, American Medical Association, Society of Gastrointestinal Radiologists, and the American College of Radiology. Dr. Brink has published more than 110 articles, reviews and books.

The 2007 Annual Meeting of NCRP has as its theme, *Advances in Radiation Protection in Medicine*. The Sinclair Address and the other sessions of the 2007 Annual Meeting are open with no registration fee to all individuals with an interest in radiation protection and measurements.
