

## ***New Members Elected***

BETHESDA — The National Council on Radiation Protection and Measurements (NCRP) has elected six new members to its Council, and reelected 10 other members. The election was held at the 44th NCRP Annual Business Meeting on April 15, which was held in conjunction with the 2008 NCRP Annual Meeting on the topic of *Low Dose and Low Dose-Rate Radiation Effects and Models*.

NCRP was chartered by Congress in 1964 under Public Law 88-376 to serve as a nonprofit organization that represents a national resource on topics related to radiation protection and radiation quantities, units and measurements. NCRP's mission is to formulate and widely disseminate information, guidance and recommendations on radiation protection and measurements which represent the consensus of leading scientific thinking. The Council's mission also encompasses the responsibility to facilitate and stimulate cooperation among organizations concerned with the scientific and related aspects of radiation protection and measurements.

There are 100 elected members of the Council, who are recognized as leaders in many scientific fields of relevance to radiation protection and measurements in medicine, homeland security, environmental protection, nuclear technology, and public and occupational radiation exposures.
